Our current location is under lease, which will be ending June 2015. As a result of this, it has become necessary to establish a permanent Islamic Center for us and our future generations, Insha'Allah.

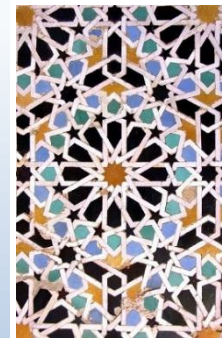
